

## Editorial

The present supplementary issue of *Note di Matematica* contains the peer-reviewed contributions presented at the *Second International Conference on Differential Geometry* (ICDG FEZ 2024), held from 28 to 31 October 2024 in Fez, the spiritual capital of Morocco. All manuscripts included herein underwent the journal's standard rigorous peer review process, adhering to the same high standards of scientific quality as contributions to its regular issues.

The Second International Conference on Differential Geometry was established as a platform to bring together leading experts and early career researchers for the exchange of ideas and the discussion of recent advances in the field. The scientific program was organized into four thematic sections: Riemannian and pseudo-Riemannian Geometry (including Finsler Geometry); Geometry of Submanifolds; Geometric Structures and Representation Theory; and Geometry with Applications, encompassing topics in physics, imaging and vision, and artificial intelligence. An additional general section was dedicated to promoting the participation of doctoral candidates from the host institution.

The conference gathered over ninety participants from twenty countries, emphasizing its international scope. The scientific program featured thirteen invited lectures of fifty minutes, thirteen contributed talks of thirty minutes and thirty eight short presentations of twenty minutes each. Complementing the formal program, a series of social events provided an environment conducive to informal scientific exchange and collaboration.

The Editors express their sincere gratitude to all Participants, whose contributions, discussions and engagement ensured the success of the conference. We are particularly indebted to the Authors who submitted their work for inclusion in this volume, and to the Referees of these contributions, whose meticulous evaluations upheld the scientific standards of these proceedings.
